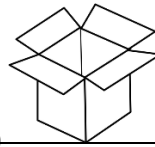




“Self-Reliance” paragraph 1

<p>Definition(s)</p> <p>Following the norms Doing what is customary or “staying inside the box”</p>	<p>Characteristics</p> <p>People might call it the “normal way.” Often is unimaginative or simplistic Doesn’t generally get too much criticism</p>
<p>conventional (adj.)</p>	
<p>A conventional wedding is in a church and the bride wears white and walks down the aisle to a song like Mendelssohn’s Wedding March. A conventional way to greet someone is with a handshake.</p> <p>Examples</p>	<p>An unconventional wedding could be on a dude ranch with the bride wearing jeans and cowboy boots & walking to her partner to a fiddler’s tune. An unconventional way of greeting someone might be slapping them on the butt.</p> <p>Non-Examples</p>
